Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Once more, we invite you and your family to continue to assist Holy Mass. As it is a crucial part of strengthening your child's Catholic faith, regular attendance at Holy Mass is a <u>requirement of</u> <u>the Faith Formation Program</u>. Parents are the primary catechists of their children; they are responsible for taking their children to Holy Mass. Children should attend <u>weekend</u> Holy Mass at our St.Agatha's Church with their parents and give their offering envelopes. As a reminder, on each envelope, the <u>student's name, grade, and the date must be clearly written down</u>.

Holy Mass provides your children an opportunity to encounter Jesus in the Word of God and the Eucharist. It prepares your child for their sacraments, such as Confession, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation. In addition, instilling the habit and tradition of assisting Holy Mass from a young age lays a strong foundation for a lifelong commitment to live out the Catholic Faith and follow Jesus into adulthood. While we understand the challenges of busy working schedules, we encourage you to prioritize Holy Mass. Your active participation sets a powerful example for your child to follow in your footsteps.
